CarBon and ROEV Launch Australia's First 4x4 Electric Hilux

Escalating demand from the resources and construction sectors will see production of over 1000 electric Hiux utes in the first 12 months, with CarBon securing more than half of these to supply commercial fleet operators eager to transition to zero emissions transport.

CarBon founder and CEO Scott Gillespie said many of the company's electric 4x4 Hiluxes would take part in a major Pilot Program in WA's northwest, where several resources companies will implement the vehicles into their operations.
